SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS

Access Line - An arrangement which connects the Customer's location to the Carrier's designated point of presence or network switching center.

Authorized User - A person, firm or corporation, or any other entity authorized by the Customer to communicate utilizing the Company's services.

Carrier or Company - TALK AMERICA INC. unless otherwise indicated by the context.

Customer - The person, firm, corporation, or other entity which orders, cancels, amends, or uses service and is responsible for the payment of charges and compliance with the Company's tariff.

Customer Premises Equipment - Terminal equipment, as defined herein, which is located on the Customer's premises.

Day Rate Period - After 8:00 am to, but not including, 5:00 pm Monday through Friday.

PUC - Refers to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

Special Access Origination/Termination - Where originating or terminating access between the Customer and the interexchange carrier is provided on dedicated circuits. The Local Access Provider (eg. LEC) provides these dedicated circuits from the Customer's location to the Company's point of presence. The rates and charges for dedicated circuits are determined by the access provider and the Customer is responsible for payment of these charges to the provider.

Subscriber - See Customer.

Switched Access Origination/Termination - Where originating or terminating access between the Customer and the interexchange carrier is provided on local exchange company Feature Group circuits.

Travel Card - A proprietary calling card offered by the Company which enables the Customer to use the Company's service by dialing a Company-provided access number.

V & H Coordinates - Geographic points which define the originating and terminating points of a call in mathematical terms so that the airline mileage of the call may be determined. Call mileage is used for the purposed of rating calls.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Description of Service.

TALK.com provides direct dialed (1+) service for communications originating and terminating within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under terms of this tariff. Operator Services are not furnished by TALK.com. Operator Services will be provided and billed by the underlying carrier at rates as described in Section 3.D of this tariff.

1. TALK.com SDN Service

TALK.com SDN Service allows Customers to place direct dialed calls to terminating locations. Customers are presubscribed to the TALK.com network. Calls are placed by dialing "1+" and the destination telephone number, including the area code, if applicable. Customers may access TALK.com SDN Service through switched or dedicated access facilities.

2. TALK.com 800 Service

TALK.com 800 Service is an inward WATS service. It permits termination of interstate and intrastate calls from diverse geographic locations to Customer local exchange lines or to dedicated access facilities. With TALK.com 800 Service, the Customer is billed for the call rather than the call originator.

3. Travel Card Service

Travel Card Service offers TALK.com Customers the ability to place calls while away from the home or office using a special access code and personal identification number. Usage charges and a per call charge applies.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)

B. Service Availability.

Service is available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week. The Company offers service to all those who desire to purchase service from the Company consistent with all provisions of this tariff.

- 1. The Company reserves the right to discontinue service when necessitated by conditions beyond its control, or when the Customer is using the service in violation of the provisions of this tariff, or in violation of the law.
- 2. Service is offered subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and equipment, or both facilities and equipment, and subject to the provisions of this tariff.
- 3. The Company does not undertake to transmit messages, but offers the use of its facilities when available, and will not be liable for errors in transmission or for failure to establish connections.
- 4. All facilities provided under this tariff are directly or indirectly controlled by TALK.com and the Customer may not transfer or assign the use of service or facilities without the express written consent of the Company. Such transfer or assignment shall only apply where there is no interruption of the use or location of the service or facilities.
- 5. Prior written permission from the Company is required before any assignment or transfer. All regulations and conditions contained in this tariff shall apply to all such permitted assignees or transferees, as well as all conditions of service.
- 6. Service is available in equal access areas only.
- 7. The Company reserves the right to block service to or from certain NPA-NXX's to control the risk of fraud. Service will be restored as soon as it can be restored without undue risk.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)

- C. Billing and Payment For Service.
 - 1. Timing of Calls

Billing for calls placed over the network is based in part on the duration of the call.

- a. Timing for all calls begins when the called party answers the call (i.e. when two way communications are established.) Answer detection is based on standard industry answer detection methods, including hardware and software answer detection.
- b. Chargeable time for all calls ends when one of the parties disconnects from the call.
- c. Minimum call duration for billing purposes is eighteen (18) seconds unless otherwise specified in the individual rate schedules of this tariff.
- d. The initial period for all calls is eighteen (18) seconds or fraction thereof, regardless of the rate period.
- e. The additional period for all calls is six (6) seconds regardless of the rate period. If the additional period usage is less than six (6) seconds, it will be billed at the full six (6) second rate.
- f. There is no billing applied for incomplete calls.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)

C. Billing and Payment For Service, (Cont'd.)

2. Payment for Service

The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services and equipment furnished to the Customer or to an Authorized User of the Customer by the Company.

All charges due by the Customer are payable to the Company or to any agency duly authorized to receive such payments. Any objections to billed charges must be promptly reported to the Company or the Company's billing agent. Adjustments to Customer's bills shall be made to the extent that circumstances exist which reasonably indicate that such changes are appropriate.

If any portion of the payment is not received by the due date or is received by the Company in funds that are not immediately available by that date, then a late payment penalty shall be due to the Company. The late payment penalty shall be the portion of the payment not received by the date due, multiplied by a late payment fee of 1.5% per month for business Customers and 1.25% for residential Customers.

A Collection Fee in addition to the Late Payment Charge of one and one half percent (1.5%) of the unpaid balance will be applied to the accounts of business subscribers with any unpaid balance when the previous month's bill has not been paid in full prior to the next billing date.

 - A. SpeedPay

If the Customer's account is delinquent or when the Customer calls the Company's business office to make payment arrangement, the Customer will be given the option to pay via electronic payment system, SpeedPay. The Customer electing SpeedPay will be notified in advance of an additional SpeedPay processing fee of \$5.00. The Customer whose service has been disconnected may be required to reestablish service using SpeedPay and will be assessed the \$5.00 SpeedPay processing fee.

3. Establishment of Credit

No deposit will be required for service.

4. Cost of Collection

The Customer shall be liable to the Company for all costs of collection.

 - 5. Billing Disputes
 - a. Billing disputes shall be processed by the Company or its billing agent(s) consistent with Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code Chapter 64.
 - b. Customers unsatisfied with the Company's handling of a dispute may contact the Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services.
 - 6. Convenience Fee

In the event a business Customer makes a one-time or recurring payment using a credit card, a Convenience Fee Charge may apply. Any payments for a deposit or advance payment to establish new service are excluded from the Convenience Fee Charge. This charge does not apply to residential Customers or to business Customers that make payment using their financial institution's bill payment service, Customers with negotiated contracts that do not allow the assessment of this fee, or Customers without a computer. This fee will be assessed at the point of payment and will not appear on the Customer's invoice.

- D. Cancellation or Termination of Service.
 - 1. Presubscribed Customers may cancel service at any time by providing the Company with written notification. Customers subscribed to special calling plans or promotional offers may cancel these services by calling the customer service number on all Company bills. Casual callers may discontinue service by not dialing the Company's access code.
 - 2. The Company may terminate service to a Customer for nonpayment of undisputed charges or other violation of this tariff or provision of law upon 10 days written notice to the Customer without incurring any liability for damages due to loss of telephone service to the Subscriber.
 - 3. The Company may terminate service without notice in the event of unauthorized or fraudulent use of service. Whenever service is discontinued for fraudulent use of service, the Company may, before restoring service, require the Customer to make, at his or her own expense, all changes in facilities or equipment necessary to eliminate illegal use and to pay an amount reasonably estimated as the loss in revenues resulting from such fraudulent use.

E. Liabilities of the Company

- 1. The Company's liability for damages arising out of mistakes, interruptions, omissions, delays, errors, or defects in transmission which occur in the course of furnishing service or facilities, in no event shall exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the Customer for the period during which the faults in transmission occur.
- 2. The Company shall not be liable for any claim or loss, expense or damage (including indirect, special or consequential damage), for any interruption, delay, error, omission, or defect in any service, facility or transmission provided under this tariff, if caused by any person or entity other than the Company, by any malfunction of any service or facility provided by any other carrier, by an act of God, fire, war, civil disturbance, or act of government, or by any other cause beyond the Company's direct control.

 - 3. The Company shall not be liable for, and shall be fully indemnified and held harmless by the Customer against any claim or loss, expense, or damage (including indirect, special or consequential damage) for defamation, libel, slander, invasion, infringement of copyright or patent, unauthorized use of any trademark, trade name or service mark, unfair competition, interference with or misappropriation or violation of any contract, proprietary or creative right, or any other injury to any person, property or entity arising out of the material, data, information, or other content revealed to, transmitted, or used by the Company under this tariff; or for any act or omission of the Customer; or for any personal injury or death of any person caused directly or indirectly by the installation, maintenance, location, condition, operation, failure, presence, use or removal of equipment or wiring provided by the Company, if not directly caused by negligence of the Company.
 - 4. The Company shall not be liable for any defacement of or damages to the premises of a Customer resulting from the furnishing of service which is not the direct result of the Company's negligence.
 - 5. The Company is not liable for any act or omission of any other entity furnishing a portion of the service or any acts or omission of the Customer.
 - 6. Service furnished by the Company may be interconnected with the services or facilities of other carriers or private systems. However, service furnished is provided solely by the Company and is not a joint undertaking with other parties. No third party provider or their directors, officers or employees that are directly or indirectly associated with the Company's furnishing of its services shall be liable to the Customer for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential, reliance, exemplary, punitive or other damages arising out of a service failure.

F. Interconnection

Service furnished by TALK.com may be connected with the services or facilities of other carriers. Such service or facilities are provided under the terms, rates and conditions of the other carrier. The Customer is responsible for all charges billed by other carriers for use in connection with TALK.com's service. Any special interface equipment or facilities necessary to achieve compatibility between carriers is the responsibility of the Customer.

G. Mileage Calculation

The Company uses the industry standard V & H coordinate method of calculating mileage between the originating and terminating points of a call for the purpose of determining the appropriate rate mileage band.

H. Rate Periods

Unless otherwise indicated elsewhere in this tariff, all usage-based rates in Section 3.0 are subject to the following time-of-day, day-of-week, and holiday rate periods:

- 1. Day Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 8:00 AM to, but not including, 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
- 2. Evening Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 5:00 PM to, but not including, 11:00 PM Sunday through Friday.
- 3. Night/Weekend Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 11:00 PM to, but not including 8:00 AM all days, 8:00 AM to, but not including, 11:00 PM Saturday; 8:00 AM to, but not including, 5:00 PM Sunday.

H. Rate Periods, (Cont'd.)

- 4. Holiday Rates Apply to that portion of a call occurring on Company acknowledged Holidays. The rate is equivalent to the Evening Rate unless a lower rate would normally apply. Holiday rates apply on New Year's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
- 5. When a call is established in one rate period and ends in another rate period, the rate in effect at the calling station applies to the portion of the call occurring within that rate period. When a unit of time is split between two rate periods, the rate applicable to that unit of time is based on the rate period in which it began.

I. Promotional Offerings

The Company may from time to time engage in special promotional trial service offerings of limited duration, not to exceed ninety days, designed to attract new Subscribers or to increase Subscriber awareness of a particular service offering. Such promotional offerings will be limited to specific dates, times, and locations. Except for the rates charged under such promotions, all other terms and conditions of service contained in this tariff will apply to TALK.com's promotional service offerings.

J. Reservation of 800 Numbers

The Company will make every effort to reserve 800 vanity numbers for customers, but makes no guarantee or warranty that the requested number(s) will be available.

K. Taxes and Fees

- 1. All state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items on the Customer's bill and are not included in the quoted rates and charges set forth in this tariff.
- 2. To the extent that a municipality, other political subdivision or local agency of government, or Commission imposes upon and collects from the Company a gross receipts tax, occupation tax, license tax, permit fee, franchise fee, or regulatory fee, such taxes and fees shall, insofar as practicable and allowed by law, be billed pro rata to Customers receiving service from the Company within the territorial limits of such municipality, other political subdivision or local agency of government.
- 3. The Company may adjust its rates and charges or impose additional rates and charges on its Customers in order to recover amounts it is required by governmental or quasi-governmental authorities to collect from or pay to others in support of statutory or regulatory programs.
 - A. Public Pay Telephone Surcharge

In order to recover the Company's expenses to comply with the FCC's pay telephone compensation plan effective on October 7, 1997 (FCC 97-371), an undiscountable per call charge is applicable to all interstate, intrastate and international calls that originate from any domestic pay telephone used to access the Company's services. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge, which is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service, applies for the use of the instrument used to access the Company service and is unrelated to the Company's service accessed from the pay telephone.

K. Taxes and Fees, Cont'd.

A. Public Pay Telephone Surcharge, cont=d.

Pay telephones include coin-operated and coinless phones owned by local telephone companies, independent companies and other interexchange carriers. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge applies to the initial completed call and any reoriginated call (i.e., using the "#" symbol).

Whenever possible, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge will appear on the same invoice containing the usage charges for the surcharged call. In cases where proper pay telephone coding digits are not transmitted to the Company prior to completion of a call, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge may be billed on a subsequent invoice after the Company has obtained information from a carrier that the originating station is an eligible pay telephone.

The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge does not apply to calls placed from pay telephones at which the Customer pays for service by inserting coins during the progress of the call.

3.0 RATES

A. General

Each Customer is charged individually for each call placed through the Company. Customers are billed based on their use of TALK.com's long distance service. Charges may vary by service offering, time of day, day of week, type of access, distance of the call and/or call duration.

For the purpose of computing charges in this tariff, a month is considered to have thirty (30) days.

Special access channels, if utilized, are provided and billed to the Customer by the Company or by an authorized access provider, such as a Local Exchange Company.
